

[REPUBLIC ACT NO. 8813, August 21, 2000]

**AN ACT DECLARING MARCH TWENTY-TWO OF EVERY YEAR AS
MALAYBALAY CITY CHARTER DAY AND A SPECIAL WORKING
HOLIDAY IN THE CITY OF MALAYBALAY IN ORDER TO
COMMEMORATE THE ANNIVERSARY OF THE SAID CITY**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in
Congress assembled:*

SECTION 1. In order to commemorate the charter anniversary of the City of Malaybalay, March twenty-two of every year is hereby declared as Malaybalay City Charter Day and a special working holiday in the said city.

SEC. 2. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
