

[REPUBLIC ACT NO. 7255, March 20, 1992]

**AN ACT DECLARING EVERY 21ST DAY OF JUNE AS A SPECIAL
NONWORKING HOLIDAY IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF
CABARROGUIS, PROVINCE OF QUIRINO, TO BE KNOWN AS
"ARAW NG CABARROGUIS"**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in
Congress assembled:*

SECTION 1. June 21st of every year is hereby declared as a special nonworking holiday in the Municipality of Cabarroguis, Province of Quirino, to be known as "Araw ng Cabarroguis."

SEC. 2. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
