AN ACT CHANGING THE NAME OF THE SILING BATA ELEMENTARY SCHOOL SITUATED IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF PANDI, PROVINCE OF BULACAN, TO MATIAS SALVADOR MEMORIAL ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:
