## [ REPUBLIC ACT NO. 5997, August 04, 1969 ]

## AN ACT GRANTING ENRICA M. REYES GARCIA A TEMPORARY PERMIT TO CONSTRUCT, ESTABLISH, OPERATE AND MAINTAIN A COMMERCIAL RADIO BROADCASTING STATION IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF KALIBO, PROVINCE OF AKLAN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress, assembled;

SECTION 1. Subject to the provisions of the Constitution, Enrica M. Reyes Garcia is hereby granted a temporary permit to construct, establish, operate and maintain in the Municipality of Kalibo, Province of Aklan, subject to the approval of the Secretary of Public Works and Communications, a commercial radio broadcasting station in the Municipality of Kalibo, Province of Aklan.

SEC. 2. The President of the Philippines shall have the power and authority to permit the location of said radio station or any of them on lands of the public domain under such terms and conditions as he may prescribe.

SEC. 3. This temporary permit shall continue to be in force during the time that the Government has not yet established any similar service in the places selected by the grantee and is granted upon the express condition that the same shall be void unless the construction of the said radio station be begun within one year from the date of approval of this Act and be completed within three years from said date,

SEC. 4. The grantee shall not engage in the domestic business of telecommunications in the Philippines with out further special approval of the Congress of the Philippines, it being understood that the purpose of this temporary permit is to secure to the grantee the right to construct, establish, operate and maintain said stations in such places within the Philippines as the interest of the grantee and of her trade and business may justify.

SEC. 5. This temporary permit shall not take effect until the Secretary of Public Works and Communications shall have allotted to the grantee the frequencies and wave lengths to be used thereunder, but the grantee may use the international distress frequency of five hundred kilocycles and the high distress frequency of eight thousand two hundred eighty kilocycles whenever necessary.

SEC. 6. No fees are chargeable as the radio stations that may be established by virtue of this Act shall engage in communications regarding the grantee's business only.

SEC. 7. The grantee shall so construct and operate said radio station so as not to
