[REPUBLIC ACT NO. 4666, June 18, 1966]

AN ACT PROHIBITING THE EXPORTATION OF FIBERS (*BUNTAL*) OR FILAMENTS OF THE PLANT COMMONLY KNOWN AS "BURI" OR SEEDS OR SEEDLINGS THEREOF, REPEALING FOR THIS PURPOSE COMMONWEALTH ACT NUMBERED FIVE HUNDRED EIGHTY-FIVE AND REPUBLIC ACT NUMBERED THREE HUNDRED NINETEEN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, corporation, firm, or association, to export to any foreign country fibers (*buntal*) or filaments of the plant commonly known as "*buri*" (*corypha elata*), or seeds or seedlings thereof.

SEC. 2. Any violation of this Act shall be punished by imprisonment of not less than two months nor more than one year, or a line of not less than one thousand pesos nor more than five thousand pesos, or both, at the discretion of the Court.

SEC. 3. Commonwealth Act Numbered Five hundred eighty-five and Republic Act Numbered Three hundred nineteen are hereby repealed.

SEC. 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
