[REPUBLIC ACT NO. 4075, June 18, 1964]

AN ACT GRANTING TEODORO N. ROMASANTA A TEMPORARY PERMIT TO ESTABLISH, MAINTAIN AND OPERATE RADIOTELEPHONE AND RADIOTELEGRAPH COASTAL STATIONS, WITH THE CORRESPONDING RELAY STATIONS AND PUBLIC FIXED AND PUBLIC BASED AND LAND MOBILE STATIONS FOR THE TRANSMISSION AND RECEPTION OF RADIOTELEPHONE AND RADIOTELEGRAPH COMMUNICATIONS WITHIN THE PHILIPPINES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. There is hereby granted to Teodoro N. Romasanta, his successors or assigns, a temporary permit to establish, maintain and operate radiotelephone and radiotelegraph coastal stations, with the corresponding relay stations and public fixed and public based and land mobile stations for the transmission and reception of radiotelephone and radiotelegraph, communications within the Philippines and with vessels at sea and aircrafts over the air subject to the approval of the Secretary of Public Works and Communications: *Provided, however,* That the grantee shall only establish and operate such public fixed and public based and land mobile stations in lumber and mining concessions, farms, municipalities and other places not at present served by public radiotelegraph and/or radiotelephone systems.

SEC. 2. The President of the Philippines shall have the power and authority to permit the location on the public domain upon such terms as he may prescribe any or all of the land radio stations that may be established under this Act.

SEC. 3. This temporary permit shall continue to be in force during the time that the Government has not established similar service at the places selected by the grantee, and is made upon the express condition that the same shall be void unless the construction of said stations be begun within three years from the date of apppoval of this Act and be completed within five years from said date.

SEC. 4. A special right is hereby reserved to the President of the Philippines in time of war, insurrection, public peril, calamity or disaster to cause the closing of the stations or to authorize the temporary use or possession thereof by any department of the Government, upon payment of just compensation.

SEC. 5. The grantee, his successors or assigns, shall hold the national, provincial and municipal governments of the Philippines harmless from all claims, accounts, demands, or actions arising out of accidents or injuries, whether to property or to persons caused by the construction or operation of the stations for reception and transmission of wireless messages by the grantee, his successors or assigns.
