[REPUBLIC ACT NO. 3932, June 18, 1964]

AN ACT GRANTING THE CONCEPCION INDUSTRIES, INCORPORATED, A FRANCHISE TO CONSTRUCT, MAINTAIN, AND OPERATE RADIOTELEPHONE STATIONS FOE THE TRANSMISSION AND RECEPTION OF RADIO COMMUNICATIONS WITHIN THE PHILIPPINES.

Be it enacted by the Senate mid House of Representatives of the. Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. There is hereby granted to the Concepcion Industries, Incorporated, a Filipino corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the Philippines, with principal office in the Municipality of Makati, Province of Rizal, Philippines, its successors and assigns, and herein referred to as the grantee, a franchise to construct, install, maintain and operate in the Philippines, at such places as the conduct and operation of the business of the said corporation may require, subject to the approval of the Secretary of Public Works and Communications, or any proper licensing authority of the Government, radiotelephone communication stations; to provide private radio communication services and equipment to individuals, firms, companies and corporations within their respective internal framework, and/or to communicate from within with grantee's station or stations in the network, fixed, land-based and land mobile stations.

SEC. 2. A special right is reserved to the President of the Philippines in time of war, rebellion, public peril, calamity, emergency, disaster or disturbance of peace or order, to take over and operate the said station or to authorize the temporary use and operation thereof by any department of the Government upon due compensation to the grantee for the use of said stations during the period when they shall be so operated.

SEC. 3. The President of the Philippines shall have the power and authority to permit the construction of said stations or any of them on any land of the public domain upon such terms and conditions as he may prescribe.

SEC. 4. This franchise shall continue for a period of twenty-five years from the date the first of said stations shall be placed in operation and is granted upon the express condition that same shall be void unless the construction of one or two stations be begun within two years from the date of the approval of this Act.

SEC. 5. The grantee, its successors or assigns, shall so construct and operate its radio stations as not to interfere with the operation of other radio stations maintained and operated in the Philippines.
