[REPUBLIC ACT NO. 3177, June 17, 1961]

AN ACT GRANTING JULITA T. GRANA A FRANCHISE TO CONSTRUCT, OPERATE AND MAINTAIN AN ICE PLANT IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF JABONGA, PROVINCE OF AGUSAN, AND TO SELL ICE THEREIN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. Subject to the conditions imposed by this Act, there is granted to Julita T. Grana, hereinafter referred to as the grantee, a franchise to construct, operate and maintain an ice plant in the Municipality of Jabonga, Province of Agusan, for the purpose of manufacturing and distributing ice therein and to charge and collect a schedule of prices and rates for the ice so furnished, which schedule of prices and rates shall at all times be subject to regulation hy the Public Service Commission.

SEC. 2. Said grantee shall manufacture and supply ice up to the limit of the capacity of her plant, said limit to be determined by the Public Service Commission in such certificate of convenience and public necessity as may be issued by it as prescribed by Section four of this Act.

SEC. 3. All the apparatus and appurtenances to be used by the grantee shall be modern, safe and first class in every respect, and the grantee shall, whenever the Public Service Commission shall determine that public interest reasonably requires it, change or alter any of her apparatus and appurtenances at grantee's expense.

SEC. 4. The grantee shall not exercise any right or privilege under this franchise nor commence any construction thereunder, unless and until the grantee shall-first file with the Public Service Commission within one hundred and twenty days from the date of approval of this Act:

(1) Her written acceptance of the terms and provisions of this Act;

(2) Her written acceptance of the terms and conditions of the certificate of convenience and public necessity required by law for the granting of this franchise and issued by the Public Service Commission of the form and character provided for in Commonwealth Act Numbered One hundred forty-six, as amended; and

(3) A document or documents evidencing receipt by the Treasurer of the Philippines of the deposit or deposits required by law for each certificate of convenience and public necessity aw an earnest proof of good faith and guaranty that the grantee shall complete the work within the period to be fixed by the Commission.
