

[ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 86, September 22, 1967]

**CREATING A COMMITTEE TO EVOLVE AN EFFECTIVE PROGRAM
FOR THE SETTLEMENT OF OBLIGATIONS OF GOVERNMENT
OFFICES TO THE NATIONAL WATERWORKS AND SEWERAGE
AUTHORITY**

WHEREAS, unpaid obligations of government offices, both national and local, to the National Waterworks and Sewerage Authority (NWSA) has reached such an extent that their non-payment might cripple NWSA's ability to comply with its international loan commitments; and

WHEREAS, an effective program of payment of these obligations has to be evolved to ensure their early settlement without disrupting the essential services of government concessionaires;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, FERDINAND E. MARCOS, President of the Philippines, do hereby create a committee to draft and carry out a program for the settlement of obligations to the NWSA of national and local offices, including government owned or controlled corporations, composed of the following:
