

[ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 10, May 13, 1966]

**CREATING A NATIONAL COMMITTEE TO TAKE CHARGE OF THE
CELEBRATION OF PHILIPPINE INDEPENDENCE DAY ON JUNE 12,
1966**

Pursuant to the powers vested in me by law, I, FERDINAND E. MARCOS, President of the Philippines, do hereby create a National Committee to take charge of the celebration of Philippine Independence Day on June 12, 1966.
