

[ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 15, July 27, 1966]

DESIGNATING THE MEMBERS OF THE PHILIPPINE COMMITTEE THAT WILL CONSIDER WITH THE MALAYSIAN GOVERNMENT WAYS AND MEANS TO IMPLEMENT THE MALAYSIAN GOVERNMENT'S ASSURANCES TO ASSIST IN THE PHILIPPINE ANTI-SMUGGLING DRIVE.

WHEREAS, it is deemed necessary that a Philippine Committee be designated to sit down with a counterpart group of the Malaysian Government for the purpose of considering ways and means to implement the Malaysian Government's assurances to assist in the Philippine anti-smuggling drive;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, FERDINAND E. MARCOS, President of the Philippines, pursuant to the powers vested in me by law, do hereby constitute and designate the members of the Philippine Committee as follows:
