[ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 225, December 01, 1953]

CREATING A COMMITTEE TO TAKE CHARGE OF THE INAUGURATION OF THE PRESIDENT AND THE VICE-PRESIDENT OF THE PHILIPPINES ON DECEMBER 30, 1953

By virtue of the powers vested in me by law, I, Elpidio Quirino, President of the Philippines, do hereby create a Committee to take charge of the inauguration of the President and the Vice-President of the Philippines on December 30, 1953. The Committee shall be composed of the following:

The Committee is hereby empowered to call upon any department, bureau, office, agency or instrumentality of the Government for such assistance, data and information as it may need in discharging its duties.
