

[EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 221, March 21, 1970]

RECONSTITUTING THE PEACE AND ORDER COORDINATING COUNCIL

Pursuant to the authority conferred upon me by law, and realizing the need for the active participation of citizen groups in the over-all drive for peace and order, I, FERDINAND E. MARCOS, President of the Philippines, do hereby reconstitute the Peace and Order Coordinating Council to be composed of the following:

Representative of the Catholic Group	– Member
Representative of the Protestant Group	– Member
Representative of the Iglesia ni Kristo	– Member
Representative of the Civic Assembly of Women	– Member
Representative of the Youth Group	– Member
A representative each of two civic organizations	– Member

This supersedes Executive Order No. 122 dated March 11, 1968.
