

**[EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 211-A, November 29,
1965]**

**CREATING THE MUNICIPALITY OF TULOADATA IN THE
PROVINCE OF LANA DEL SUR**

Upon the recommendation of the Provincial Board of Lanao del Sur and pursuant to the provisions of Section 68 of the Revised Administrative Code, there is hereby created in the province of Lanao del Sur a municipality to be known as Tuloadata to consist of the following barrios and sitios of the municipality of Marantao, said province, with the seat of government at the barrio of Maul:

The municipality of Tuloadata shall begin to exist upon the appointment and qualification of the Mayor, Vice-Mayor and a majority of the councilors thereof.
