[PHILRACOM RESOLUTION NO. 13-10, S. OF 2010, May 19, 2010]

OVERWEIGHT JOCKEY

WHEREAS, the Philippine Racing Commission (Philracom) has the exclusive jurisdiction and control over the conduct of horseracing including the framing and scheduling of races, the construction and safety of horse-racing, the allocation of prizes and the security of racing as provided in Presidential Decree No. 420;

WHEREAS, consistent with the said mandate, the Philracom, through its Regulation and Licensing Division, has noticed that the present Rules and Regulations on Horseracing do not state the penalty for jockeys who are overweight before the race leading to a change of jockey;

WHEREAS, considering the above, the Philracom has come up with the following guidelines/penalties, to wit:

1. Overweight jockey before the race leading to a change of jockey:

a. 1^{st} offense - Php1,000.00 b. 2^{nd} offense - Php2,000.00 c. 3^{rd} offense - Php4,000.00

d. 4th and succeeding offense - Philracom pleasure

2. The count will revert back to zero (0) after a clean slate of one (1) year after the last offense.

NOW THEREFORE, the Philracom resolves, as it has hereby resolved, that jockeys who are overweight before the race leading to a change of jockey shall be penalized as follows:

1. Overweight jockey before the race leading to a change of jockey:

a. 1^{st} offense - Php1,000.00 b. 2^{nd} offense - Php2,000.00 c. 3^{rd} offense - Php4,000.00

d. 4th and succeeding offense - Philracom pleasure

2. The count will revert back to zero (0) after a clean slate of one (1) year after the last offense.
