**RESOLUTION NO. R-835, S. 2009, APPLICABILITY OF
DEVELOPMENT STANDARDS TO DIFFERENT LEVELS OF HOUSING
CLASSIFICATION**

Quoted hereunder is HLURB Board Resolution No. R-835, Series of 2009, Applicability of Development Standards to Different Levels of Housing Classification, which was approved by the Board on 26 March 2009:

WHEREAS, there is a need to harmonize HUDCC classification of housing loan ceilings/packages and HLURB housing classification under PD 957 and BP 220 for consistency to avoid any confusion as to the applicable development standards;

WHEREFORE, RESOLVED as it is hereby RESOLVED to apply the following development standards to different levels of housing loan ceilings/packages:
