

[ERC RESOLUTION NO. 12, S. 2009, June 01, 2009]

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE RULES AND PROCEDURES FOR THE TEST AND MAINTENANCE OF ELECTRIC METERS OF DISTRIBUTION UTILITIES

WHEREAS, Section 16 (d), (e), (f) and (g) of Commonwealth Act No. 146 (CA 146) gives the Commission the power, upon proper notice and hearing, to fix just and reasonable standards, classifications, regulations, practices, measurements, or service to be furnished, imposed, observed and followed by any public service; to establish reasonable rules and regulations, instructions, specifications, and standards, to secure the accuracy of all meters and appliances for measurements; and to compel any public service to furnish safe, adequate, and proper service as regards the manner of furnishing the same as well as the maintenance of the necessary material and equipment;

WHEREAS, Section 17 (d) of CA 146 empowers the Commission to provide, on motion by or at the request of any consumer or user of a public service, for the examination and test of any appliance used for the measuring of any product or service of a public service;

WHEREAS, Commonwealth Act No. 349 (CA 349) created a meter laboratory that has the duty of inspecting, examining and approving periodically all meters and appliances for measurements used by all public services under the jurisdiction of the Commission to ensure their accuracy;

WHEREAS, the Energy Regulatory Commission (ERC) proposed a set of Rules and Procedures for the Test and Maintenance of Electric Meters of Distribution Utilities;

WHEREAS, the said Rules and Procedures shall provide guidance to Distribution Utilities (DUs) in the testing and maintenance of electric meters in order to ensure the highest level of confidence of the consumers on the accuracy of the DUs' billing meters;

WHEREAS, the said Rules and Procedures were posted on the ERC website and published in a newspaper of general circulation to solicit comments from interested stakeholders;

WHEREAS, expository hearing were conducted in Cebu City on January 21, 2009 and in Manila on January 23, 2009. A public consultation was also held in Manila on February 13, 2009;

WHEREAS, the revised Rules and Procedures incorporating the comments of the stakeholders were again posted on the ERC website on April 20, 2009.

WHEREAS, the Rules and Procedures were again revised to consider the comments submitted during its second posting;
