## [ BAI MEMORANDUM ORDER NO. 11, S. 2004, February 24, 2004 ]

## TEMPORARY BAN ON THE IMPORTATION OF DOMESTIC AND WILD BIRDS AND THEIR PRODUCTS INCLUDING POULTRY MEAT, DAY-OLD CHICKS, EGGS AND SEMEN ORIGINATING FROM TEXAS, USA

WHEREAS, the US Department of Agriculture confirmed the occurrence of avian influenza in Gonzalez Country, Texas, USA;

WHEREAS, a flock of 7,000 birds tested positive for avian influenza by the national reference laboratory of the USA;

WHEREAS, the Philippines imports birds from the state of Texas;

WHEREAS, there is a need to prevent the entry of avian influenza to prevent the health of the local poultry population;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, LUIS P. LORENZO, JR., Secretary of Agriculture, by the powers vested in me by law, do hereby institute the following emergency measures:

- 1. Banning the importation of domestic and wild birds and their products, including day-old chicks, eggs and semen from Texas, USA.
- 2. Immediate suspension of the processing, evaluation and issuance of veterinary quarantine clearance/ international veterinary certificate/ import permit for applications relevant to the importation of the above-stated commodities from Texas, USA by the Bureau of Animal Industry.
- 3. Stoppage and confiscation of all shipments of poultry and poultry products into the country originating from Texas, USA by all DA Quarantine Officers/ Inspectors at all major sea/airports.

This ORDER shall take effect immediately.
