

**[LTFRB MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR NO. 2004-009,
March 31, 2004]**

**IMPLEMENTATION OF PARAGRAPH (C) SECTION 5 OF
EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 202**

After consultation with the jeepney transport organizations and upon careful review of the existing fare rate structure, there is now a need to adjust the minimum kilometer benchmark from five (5) kilometers to four (4) kilometers.

Thus, pursuant to Paragraph (c), Section 5 of Executive Order No. 202, dated 19 June 1987, providing that the Board shall have the power and function **"to determine, prescribe and approve and periodically review and adjust reasonable fare rates and other related charges, relative to the operation of public land transportation services provided by motorized vehicles,"** the minimum fare of **FOUR PESOS (Php4.00)** for jeepneys nationwide shall now be based on the first **FOUR KILOMETERS** instead of the previously set five (5) kilometer-benchmark.

This Memorandum Circular modifies and/or supersedes any and all decisions and/or issuances inconsistent herewith.

This Circular shall take effect immediately.
