ADDITIONAL MEASURES TO ENSURE THE SAFETY AND SECURITY DOMESTIC PASSENGER AND/OR CARGO SHIPS

In view of the recent incidents in the country and as part of our continuing effort to ensure the safety and security of our domestic passenger and/or cargo ships and the people and goods that they carry, Flag State Administration Advisory No. 018, series of 2001 dated 02 January 2001, is hereby reiterated. All shipping companies/ship owners/operators are hereby directed to more strictly institute the following measures:

- 1. Exercise extra vigilance at <u>all entry points</u> to their premises, passenger terminals and vessels.
- 2. Check persons and/or passengers and their baggage entering the premises. Entry should be denied to anyone who refuses to submit to a security check prior to entry into passenger terminals and embarkation to a ship.
- 3. Immediately inform any of the following government agencies of any suspicious person(s)/activity(ies) movement(s) in your premises/ships and/or their immediate vicinity.
