

**[ BOC ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 2-2000,  
March 29, 2000 ]**

**ESTABLISHING THE SUPER GREEN LANE IMPORT PROCESSING  
FACILITY**

Pursuant to sections 608 and 3304, tariff and customs code of the Philippines, as amended, the following rules and regulations are hereby promulgated:

**I. OBJECTIVE.** To further enhance the Green Lane facility by providing an advance-processing mode of clearing import shipments.

**II. SCOPE.** This Order shall cover shipments to the Philippines by importers qualified for Super Green Lane transactions, as established herein which may be gradually implemented.

**III. ORGANIZATION**

A. The Commissioner of Customs shall constitute the Super Green Lane Task Group to be headed by a Deputy Commissioner to perform the following functions:

1. Identify importers qualified to avail of the SGL facility and make appropriate recommendations;
2. Conduct post clearance checks on declarations covering shipments released under the SGL facility;
3. Ensure compliance with the rules and regulations governing the establishment and operation of the Super Green Lane Facility; and
4. Such other functions as may be assigned by the Commissioner from time to time.

B. The Commissioner, upon recommendation of the Task Group, may create sub-group/s as may be necessary.

**IV. CRITERIA FOR ACCREDITATION.** The BOC shall consider, among others, the following criteria:

1. That the importer/SGL user has not been subjected to disciplinary action or similar penalties;
2. That the subject imports are not prohibited; and
3. That the importer has been transacting with the BOC for at least one (1) year and falls within the top 1000 importers in terms of duties and taxes paid.
