AMENDMENT OF SECTION 15, RULE XIV OF THE OMNIBUS RULES, BOOK V OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE CODE OF 1987

Pursuant to CSC Resolution No. 98-0064 dated Jan. 13, 1998, the Commission has amended Section 15, Rule XIV of the Omnibus Rules Implementing Book V of the Administrative Code of 1987 (Executive Order No. 292) by adding a second paragraph thereto, to read as follows:

"SECTION 15. A reprimand whether given by the Civil Service Commission or the head of department or agency shall be considered a penalty. However, a warning or an admonition shall not be considered a penalty.

"The penalty of reprimand does not include any accessory penalty nor entail the forfeiture of leave credits, retirement benefits and bonuses that may be granted."
