## [ DOJ DEPARTMENT ORDER NO. 34, February 04, 1992 ]

## AMENDING DEPARTMENT ORDER NO. 318, S. 1992. BY EXPANDING THE APPELLATE JURISDICTION OF THE REGIONAL STATE PROSECUTION OFFICES

In the interest of the public service for the efficient delivery of prosecutorial services and pursuant to existing laws, paragraph 13 of the Department Order No. 318, Series of 1992 is hereby amended to expand the appellate jurisdiction of the Regional State Prosecution Offices and shall accordingly read as follows:

"13. Resolve with finality appeals from resolutions of dismissal or provincial/city prosecutors and their assistants within the region, provided that the case is one where the offense charged is punishable by prision correctional or a fine not exceeding six thousand pesos (P6,000.00) or both such fine and imprisonment".

This Order takes effect immediately and shall remain in force until further orders.
