

[DDB BOARD REGULATION NO. 6, February 15, 1990]

AMENDING BOARD REGULATION NO. 5, SERIES OF 1972 BY INCLUDING N-HYDROXY MDA, N-ETHYL MDA AND 4-METHYLAMINOREX: THEIR SALTS, ISOMERS, AND SALTS OF ISOMERS: AND COMPOUNDS, MIXTURES, AND PREPARATIONS CONTAINING SUCH SUBSTANCES IN THE LIST OF PROHIBITED DRUGS, SUBJECT TO CERTAIN CONDITIONS.

SECTION 1. Pursuant to its powers under Section 36(a) of Republic Act No. 6425 as amended the Dangerous Drugs Board, having found after evaluation that the following substances:
