

**[ PROCLAMATION NO. 466, August 31, 2012 ]**

**DECLARING WEDNESDAY, 5 SEPTEMBER 2012, AS A SPECIAL  
(NON-WORKING) DAY IN THE CITY OF GENERAL SANTOS**
