

**[ PROCLAMATION NO. 1647, October 15, 2008 ]**

**DECLARING MONDAY, NOVEMBER 24, 2008, AS SPECIAL (NON-WORKING) DAY IN THE PROVINCE OF BENGUET**

**WHEREAS**, Sunday, November 23, 2008, marks the Foundation Day anniversary of the Province of Benguet;
