

**[ PROCLAMATION NO. 1643, October 10, 2008 ]**

**DECLARING MONDAY, NOVEMBER 10, 2008, AS SPECIAL (NON-WORKING) DAY IN THE PROVINCE OF EASTERN SAMAR**
