

[PROCLAMATION NO. 1635, October 06, 2008]

DECLARING WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 8, 2008, AS SPECIAL (NON-WORKING) DAY IN THE CITY OF KORONADAL, PROVINCE OF SOUTH COTABATO
