

[PROCLAMATION NO. 1183, December 07, 2006]

DECLARING FRIDAY, DECEMBER 22, 2006, AS SPECIAL (NON-WORKING) DAY IN THE CITY OF BAYAWAN, PROVINCE OF ORIENTAL NEGROS
