## [ PROCLAMATION NO. 856, June 09, 2005 ]

## DECLARING 13 JUNE 2005, MONDAY, AS A SPECIAL (NON-WORKING) DAY THROUGHOUT THE COUNTRY

**WHEREAS,** Independence Day which is observed as a regular holiday on June 12th of each year, commemorates the heroism and self-sacrifice of our forefathers in the struggle for national independence;

**WHEREAS,** the commemoration of Independence Day falls this year on a Sunday; and

**WHEREAS,** 13 June 2005, Monday, may be declared as a special (non-working) day pursuant to existing laws, rules and regulations.

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, EDUARDO R. ERMITA,** by authority of Her Excellency **GLORIA MACAPAGAL-ARROYO,** President of the Republic of the Philippines, do hereby declare the following:

**SECTION 1.** 13 June 2005, Monday, shall be a special (non-working) day throughout the country.

**SECTION 2.** All activities and celebrations in observance of Independence Day shall, however, remain to be observed on 12 June 2005, Sunday.

**SECTION 3.** The Department of Labor and Employment shall issue the appropriate guidelines to implement this Proclamation.
