

**[ PROCLAMATION NO. 947, November 24, 2005 ]**

**DECLARING MONDAY, DECEMBER 19, 2005 AS SPECIAL (NON-WORKING) DAY IN THE CITY OF TUGUEGARAO**

**WHEREAS**, Sunday, December 18, 2005, marks the 6th Charter Day Anniversary of the City of Tuguegarao;
