

**[ PROCLAMATION NO. 331, February 19, 2003 ]**

**DECLARING TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 25, 2003, AS A SPECIAL  
NATIONAL HOLIDAY**

**WHEREAS**, Tuesday, February 25, 2003, marks the 17th anniversary of the February 22 to 25, 1986 EDSA People Power Revolution;

**WHEREAS**, the EDSA People Power Revolution restored our democratic institutions and ushered in meaningful political, social and economic reforms in the country;

**WHEREAS**, it is fitting that the people of the Philippines be given full opportunity to honor the memory of the EDSA People Power Revolution with appropriate ceremonies.

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERTO G. ROMULO**, Executive Secretary, by order of Her Excellency, **GLORIA MACAPAGAL-ARROYO**, do hereby declare Tuesday, February 25, 2003, as a special national holiday.
