

**[ PROCLAMATION NO. 390, May 27, 2003 ]**

**DECLARING WEDNESDAY, JUNE 11, 2003, AS A SPECIAL (NON-WORKING) DAY IN THE PROVINCE OF RIZAL**

**WHEREAS**, the Province of Rizal was formally established on June 11, 1901;

**WHEREAS**, Wednesday, June 11, 2003, marks the 102nd Foundation Day anniversary of the Province of Rizal;
