

**[ PROCLAMATION NO. 393, June 02, 2003 ]**

**DECLARING WEDNESDAY, JUNE 11, 2003, AS A SPECIAL (NON-WORKING) DAY IN THE CITY OF SAGAY, PROVINCE OF NEGROS OCCIDENTAL**
