[PROCLAMATION NO. 479, January 27, 1958]

EXCLUDING FROM THE OPERATION OF PROCLAMATION NO. 101, SERIES OF 1954, WHICH RESERVED FOR EDUCATIONAL CENTER SITE PURPOSES SITUATED IN THE DISTRICT OF ERMITA, CITY OF MANILA, A PORTION OF THE LAND EMBRACED THEREIN AND RESERVING THE LAND FOR BUILDING SITE PURPOSES OF THE WORLD HEALTH ORGANIZATION (WHO)

Upon the recommendation of the Secretary of Agriculture and Natural Resources and pursuant to the authority vested in me by law, I, Carlos P. Garcia, President of the Philippines, do hereby exclude from the operation of Proclamation No. 101, series of 1954, which reserved for Educational Center site purposes situated in the District of Ermita, City of Manila, a portion of the land embraced therein and reserve the same for building site purposes of the World Health Organization (WHO) under the administration of the Secretary of Health, subject to private rights, if any there be, which portion of land is mere particularly described as follows, to wit:

World Health Organization Building Proposed Site

A parcel of land (the proposed site of World Health Organization Building and shown on the attached sketch plan), situated in the District of Ermita, City of Manila. Bounded on the NE., along line 1-2 by Taft Avenue; along lines 2-3 and 3—4 by remaining portion of this lot; and along line 4-1 by Isaac Peral Street. Beginning at a point marked-1 on the attached sketch plan, which is at the intersection of Isaac Peral Street and Taft Avenue, thence S. 28° 43′ E., 100 meters to point 2; thence S. 61° 22′ W., 100 meters to point 3; thence N, 28° 43′ W., 100 meters to point 4; thence N. 61° 22′ E., 100 meters to point 1, point of beginning; containing an approximate area of 10,000 square meters.

NOTE: All data are approximate and subject to future surveys.
