## [ PROCLAMATION NO. 466, December 12, 1957 ]

## RESERVING A PARCEL OF THE PUBLIC DOMAIN FOR NATIONAL PARK PURPOSES TO BE KNOWN AS "MAINIT HOT SPRINGS NATIONAL PARK", SITUATED IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF COMPOSTELA, PROVINCE OF DAVAO, ISLAND OF MINDANAO

Upon the recommendation of the Secretary of Agriculture and Natural Resources as Chairman of the Commission on Parks and Wildlife, and pursuant to the provisions of Section One of Act Numbered Thirty-nine hundred and Fifteen, as amended, and of Section Two of Republic Act Numbered Eight Hundred and Twenty-six, I, CARLOS P. GARCIA, President of the Philippines, do hereby withdraw from sale or settlement and reserve for national park purposes to be known as "Mainit Hot Springs National Park" under the administration of the Commission on Parks and Wildlife, subject to private rights, if any there be, the following parcel of land of the public domain, situated in the Municipality of Compostela, Province of Davao, Island of Mindanao, and more particularly described as follows, to wit:

Beginning at Corner marked "1" on Bureau of Forestry Map N.P.-35, a malugai tree, 60 cm. in dia., marked L.C. 330/31, identical to Corner 5, Block III, Davao Project No. 17-F, which is approximately N. 86 deg. E., 6940 m. from BLLM No. 20 of Compostela Cadastre No. 282; thence following Inoparan Creek upstream in general southeasterly direction about 210 m. to Corner 2, a miscellaneous specie, 25 cm. in dia., marked N.P. 332/4, located at the junction of creeks; thence following Inoparan Creek upstream in general southwesterly direction about 450 m. to Corner 3, a balobo tree, 30 cm. in dia., marked N.P. 690/5, located at the south bank of creek; thence following Inoparan Creek upstream in general southeasterly direction about 465 m. to Corner 4, a santiki tree, 30 cm. in dia., marked N.P. 690/10, located at the junction of creeks; thence following Inoparan Creek upstream in general southeasterly direction about 195 m. to Corner 5, a miscellaneous specie, 20 cm. in dia., marked N.P. 690/12, located at the junction of Inoparan Creek and trail; thence following Inoparan Creek upstream in general southeasterly direction about 390 m. to Corner 6, a mayapis tree, 30 cm. in dia., marked N.P. 690/17, located at the junction of creeks; thence following Inoparan Creek upstream in general southeasterly direction about 465 m. to Corner 7, a balobo tree, 40 cm. in dia., marked N.P. 690/22, located at the source of Inoparan Creek; thence following Inoparan Creek upstream in general southeasterly direction about 180 m. to Corner 8, a miscellaneous specie, 30 cm. in dia., marked N.P. 690/27, located at the junction of creeks, thence S. 8 deg. E., 240 m. to Corner 9, a balobo tree, 30 cm. in dia., marked N.P. 690/28, located at the top of ridge; thence S. 8 deg. E., 255 m. to Corner 10, a red lauan tree, 60 cm. in dia., marked N.P. 690/29, located at the south side of slope; thence S. 8 deg., E. 255 m. to Corner 11, a miscellaneous specie, 25 cm. in dia., marked N.P. 690/30, located at the south side of slope; thence S. 8 deg. E., 255 m. to Corner 12, a miscellaneous specie, 30 cm. in dia., marked N.P. 690/31, located at the north side of slope; thence S. 8 deg.
