

[PROCLAMATION NO. 205, October 14, 1955]

DECLARING FRIDAY, OCTOBER 28, 1955, AS A SPECIAL PUBLIC HOLIDAY IN THE PROVINCES OF LANAOS, DAVAO, PALAWAN, COTABATO, SULU, BUKIDNON, ZAMBOANGA DEL NORTE, AND ZAMBOANGA DEL SUR, AND IN THE CITIES OF DAVAO, DANSALAN, ILIGAN, ZAMBOANGA, AND BASILAN

In commemoration of the Muslim national feast of Mawledin Nabi (Muslim Christmas), I, Ramon Magsaysay, President of the Philippines, by virtue of the powers vested in me by section 30 of the Revised Administrative Code, do hereby declare Friday, October 28, 1955, as a special public holiday in the provinces of Lanao, Davao, Palawan, Cotabato, Sulu, Bukidnon, Zamboanga del Norte, and Zamboanga del Sur, and in the cities of Davao, Dansalan, Iligan, Zamboanga, and Basilan.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the seal of the Republic of the Philippines to be affixed.

Done in the City of Manila, this 14th day of October, in the year of Our Lord, nineteen hundred and fifty-five, and of the Independence of the Philippines, the tenth.
