STATUS MARITIME CORPORATION, COSMOSHIP MANAGEMENT S.A. AND MILAGRITA JIMENEZ, PETITIONERS, VS. NATIONAL LABOR RELATIONS COMMISSION (NLRC) AND BELTRAN A. PERITO, RESPONDENTS.

DECISION

YBAÑEZ, J.:

This is a Petition for Certiorari with prayer for the issuance of the writs of temporary restraining and/or preliminary injunction, assailing the Decision dated 27 March 2013, [1] and the Resolution dated 24 March 2013 of the NLRC in NLRC LAC (OFW-M)-02-000225-13, affirming the Decision dated 4 December 2012, [2] of the Labor Arbiter in NLRC RAB No. NCR Case No. (M) NCR-08-12790-12, disposing that:

"WHEREFORE, premises considered, judgment is entered FINDING respondents **STATUS MARITIME** CORP. (Respondent/Local Agency) and/or COSMOSHIP MANAGEMENT S.A. (Respondent/Principal Abroad), MILAGRITA B. JIMENEZ (Other Respondent), jointly and severally liable to pay complainant Beltran A. Perito permanent and total disability or 100% degree of disability benefits of US\$60,000.00, ORDERING thus, said named respondents in said joint and several capacities to pay said complainant his permanent total disability benefits of US\$60,000.00 and his sick leave allowance of US\$2,800.00, and finally to pay him Attorney's fees of ten percent (10%) of the total monetary award.

SO ORDERED."

On 15 August 2013 We issued Resolution directing private respondent to file his comment to the petition (not a motion to dismiss) within ten (10) days from notice, furnishing a copy thereof to the petitioners, who may file a reply within five (5) days from receipt of private respondent's comment.

On 11 October 2013, private respondent Beltran A. Perito, through counsel, filed his Comment to the petition.^[3] And on 25 October 2013, petitioners filed their Reply thereto.^[4]

Earlier, or on 2 October 2013, petitioners, through counsel, filed an Urgent Morion For The Issuance of Temporary Restraining Order and/or Writ of Preliminary
