

[EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 43, September 05, 1966]

**AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 22 DATED OCTOBER 1, 1962,
ENTITLED "PROVIDING FOR THE IMPLEMENTING DETAILS FOR
REPUBLIC ACT NO. 2717, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE
ELECTRIFICATION ADMINISTRATION ACT."**

Pursuant to the powers vested in me by law, the following amendments to the implementing details of Republic Act No. 2717, otherwise known as the Electrification Administration Act, are hereby promulgated to govern the organization, powers, duties and functions of the Electrification Administration, in view of the expansion of activities and the necessity to reflect changes in conditions, organization, definition and distribution of work among the various departments in the Administration.

SECTION 1. Section 2 of Executive Order No. 22 dated October 1, 1962, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"SEC. 2. The Administration shall function under the Office of the President and shall consist of the Office of the Administrator, a Programming and Planning Department, an Administrative and Fiscal Department, an Accounting Department, a Loans and Investment Department and a Design, Construction and Maintenance Department."

SEC. 2. Section 3 of said Executive Order is hereby amended to read as follows:

"SEC. 3. The Office of the Administrator shall have a Deputy Administrator for Administration and Finance, a Deputy Administrator for Operations, and a Legal Staff."

SEC. 3. Section 8 of said Executive Order is hereby amended to read as follows:

"SEC. 8. (a) The Deputy Administrator for Administration and Finance, shall be delegated such powers and authority as may be necessary to enable him to discharge his functions, duties and responsibilities.

"The Deputy Administrator for Administration and Finance shall have the following functions, among others:

"1. Serve as Deputy to the Administrator in all matters relating to administration and finance;

"2. Administer the Administration's day-to-day activities, coordinate its administrative services and fiscal management and be responsible for the efficient and economical operations of the Administration;
