NOW, THEREFORE, based on the foregoing premises, the Board RESOLVED to require all contractors with License Category "AAA" to be certified to the version of ISO 9001 existing at the time of ISO registration by Contracting Fiscal year 2015-2016.

The Board further RESOLVED that the afore-stated certification shall be required of new, renewal and upgrading applications prior to the filing of their respective applications under Category "AAA".

This Resolution shall take effect starting CFY 2015-2016.
