

**[LTO MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR NO. 582-2005,
February 11, 2005]**

**IMPLEMENTING GUIDELINES IN THE ASSIGNMENT AND
ISSUANCE OF LOW-NUMBERED (PROTOCOL) LICENSE PLATES TO
MOTOR VEHICLES USED BY OFFICIALS OF THE REPUBLIC OF THE
PHILIPPINES**

Pursuant to Executive Order No. 400 dated 18 January 2005, "Regulating the Assignment and Issuance of Low-Numbered (protocol) License Plates to Motor Vehicles Used By Officials of the Republic of the Philippines", the following guidelines and procedures are hereby promulgated:

SECTION 1. The following officials shall be entitled to the use of low-numbered/protocol license plates:

OFFICIALS	ASSIGNED NUMBER
President of the Republic of the Philippines	1 and/or PANGULO
Vice-President of the Republic of the Philippines	2
Senate President	3
Speaker of the House of Representatives	4
Chief Justice of the Supreme Court	5
Cabinet Secretary	6
Senator	7
Congressman	8
Associate Justices of the Supreme Court	9
Presiding Justice and other Justices of the Court of Appeals	10
Chairman of the Commission on Elections	11
Cabinet Undersecretary	12
Solicitor General	13
Chief of Staff, AFP/Chief, PNP	14
RTC Judges	16

SECTION 2. All other officials with equivalent rank/position as the above-listed officials are also entitled to the use of low-numbered/protocol license plates subject to the approval of the Secretary of the Department of Transportation
