## [ BAI MEMORANDUM ORDER NO. 03, S. 2004, January 23, 2004 ]

## TEMPORARY BAN ON THE IMPORTATION OF DOMESTIC AND WILD BIRDS AND THEIR PRODUCTS INCLUDING POULTRY MEAT, DAY OLD CHICKS, EGGS AND SEMEN ORIGINATING FROM THAILAND

WHEREAS, the World Health Organization has confirmed the human death caused by the infection of bird flu;

WHEREAS, there is a possibility that some travelers may bring in pet birds from Thailand;

WHEREAS, there is a need to prevent the entry of HPAI virus to protect the health of the local poultry population;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, LUIS P. LORENZO, JR., Secretary of Agriculture, by the powers vested in me by law, do hereby institute the following emergency measures:

- 1. Banning the importation of domestic and wild birds and their products, including day-old chicks, eggs and semen from Thailand;
- 2. Immediate suspension of the processing, evaluation and issuance of Veterinary Quarantine Clearance/International Veterinary Certificate/Import Permit for applications relevant to the importation of the above-stated commodities from Thailand by the Bureau of Animal Industry;
- 3. Stoppage and confiscation of all shipments of poultry and poultry products into the country originating from Thailand by all DA Quarantine Inspectors/Officers at all major sea/air ports.

This Order shall take effect immediately.
