LIFTING THE TEMPORARY BAN ON THE IMPORTATION OF PORK, PORK PRODUCTS AND PORK BY-PRODUCTS FROM THE UNITED KINGDOM, EXCEPT EAST ANGLIA

The Commission of the European Communities adopted the decision stipulated in the provisions of Council Directive 80/217/EEC of 22 January 1980 introducing community measures for the control of Classical Swine Fever as last amended by the Accession of Austria, Finland and Sweden, and in particular thereof:

- 1. Article 9, paragraph 1 protection and surveillance zones were immediately established around outbreak sites in Suffolk, Norfolk and Essex. The movement of live pigs and untreated pig meat is restricted.
- 2. European Union ban has been reduced to the countries of East Anglia wherein Classical Swine Fever has been confirmed.

Based on the above declaration of the European Communities, I hereby approve the importation of pork, pork products and pork by-products from the United Kingdom, except from East Anglia.

This Order shall take effect immediately.
