IMPLEMENTING GUIDELINES ON THE ROLLBACK OF INTERISLAND LINER RATES

Pursuant to the Order of the Maritime Industry Board dated 6 May 1992 authorizing a 6 percent rollback on interisland liner shipping freight rates, the following guidelines in implementation thereof are hereby issued for compliance:

I Coverage

The freight rate rollback of 6 percent shall be applicable to all common carriers engaged in interisland liner shipping.

II Revised Schedule of Freight Rate

Taking into account the varied existing authorized freight rate levels, the following revised schedule of freight rates for each of these levels is hereby adopted:
