[Act No. 3029, March 08, 1922]

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE MEDICAL INSPECTION OF THE CHILDREN OF THE PUBLIC ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS OF THE PHILIPPINE ISLANDS

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Legislature assembled and by the authority of the same:

SECTION 1. Beginning with the month of June, nineteen hundred and twenty-two, it shall be the duty of the Director of Health to provide for the medical inspection of the children in all Government elementary schools at least once each year.

SEC. 2. The Director of Health shall detail any surgeon or officer of the Health Service to make such inspection without additional remuneration: *Provided, however,* That the taveling expenses and per diems of surgeons or health officers so detailed shall be paid out of the funds of the Bureau of Education.

SEC. 3. This Act shall take effect on its approval.
