

[Act No. 2611., February 04, 1916]

AN ACT MAKING ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATIONS FOR SUNDRY EXPENSES OF THE INSULAR GOVERNMENT FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDED DECEMBER THIRTY-FIRST, NINETEEN HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN, AND OTHER PERIODS HEREIN SPECIFIED.

By authority of the United States, be it enacted by the Philippine Legislature, that:

SECTION 1. The following sums, or so much thereof as may be respectively necessary, are hereby appropriated, out of any funds in the Insular Treasury not otherwise appropriated, in part compensation for the service of the Insular Government for the fiscal year ended December thirty-first, nineteen hundred fifteen, and other periods herein specified:

PHILIPPINE ASSEMBLY.

For the sum necessary to cover the deficit in the appropriation of the Philippine Assembly for the fiscal year nineteen hundred and fourteen

PRIVATE SECRETARIES TO THE RESIDENT COMMISSIONERS TO THE UNITED STATES.

For the sum necessary to cover the deficit in the appropriation for traveling expenses of the private secretaries to the

Resident Commissioners to the United States for the year nineteen hundred and fourteen

For payment to Captain A. F.
