

[Act No. 306, November 29, 1901]

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION FIVE OF THE CIVIL SERVICE ACT AND SECTIONS THREE AND FOUR OF ACT NUMBERED ONE HUNDRED AND SIXTY-SEVEN, EXTENDING THE PROVISIONS OF THE CIVIL SERVICE ACT, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES, BY PROVIDING FOR FURTHER EXTENSIONS OF THIS ACT.

By authority of the President of the United States, be it enacted by the United States Philippine Commission, that:

SECTION 1. Section five of Act Numbered Five, entitled "The Civil Service Act," is hereby amended by striking out in paragraph (m) the words "the Provost-Marshal-General of Manila," and inserting in lieu thereof the words, "the municipal government of Manila, subject to the provisions of Act Numbered One hundred and eighty-three;" and section three of Act Numbered One hundred and sixty-seven, entitled "An Act to amend sections two, three, and fourteen of Act Numbered One hundred and two, entitled 'An Act regulating the salaries of officers and employees in the Philippine civil service' and to amend sections five and twenty of the Civil Service Act, and for other purpose," is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:

"(u) The chiefs or heads of all Bureaus organized after July sixteenth, nineteen hundred and one, subject to the provisions and limitations of the acts organizing such Bureaus," so that section five of Act Numbered Five, entitled "The Civil Service Act," with the amendments already provided by section three of Act Numbered One hundred and sixty-seven, shall read as follows:

"SEC. 5. This Act shall apply, except as hereinafter expressly provided, to all appointments of civilians to executive positions under—

"(a) The Executive Secretary;

"(b) The United States Philippine Commission;

"(c) The Treasurer for the Islands;

"(d) The Auditor for the Islands;

"(e) The Collector of Customs for the Islands;

"(f) The Collector of Inland Revenue for the Islands;

"(g) The Director of Posts for the Islands;

"(h) The Civil Service Board;

"(i) The Bureau of Forestry;

"(j) The Bureau of Mines;
