The Telecommunications (Amendment) Act, 2009.

Short title.

Being an Act to amend the Telecommunications Act, 2006.

J Date of com-mencement.

ENACTED by the President and Members of Parliament in this present Parliament assembled.

- (a) in section 1 by the insertion at the appropriate place of the following definition:-
- "ICT" means Information and Communication Technology, which involves technology used to gather, store, use and send information, including the use of computers or any other communication system;
- (b) in subsection (1) of section 5 by the following subsection:-

"Tenure of office of members of Commission.

(1) The Chairman and other members of the Commission shall hold office for a term of five years and shall, subject to this Act, be eligible for re- appointment for another term only";

- (c) by the substitution for the words Executive Secretary wherever they appear of the words "Director-General";
- (d) by the insertion after section 9 of the following sections:-

- (a) foster and protect an efficient market in ICT;
