Short title.

An Ordinance to Make Provision for Public Holidays.

[28TH DECEMBER, 1932.]

Certain days to be public holidays. 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Public Holidays Ordinance and shall apply to the Colony and Protectorate.

2. The days mentioned in the Schedule shall be kept as public holidays in all public offices and banks in Sierra Leone:

Provided that if any such day shall fall on a Sunday, the day next following, not being itself a public holiday, shall be kept as a public holiday in lieu thereof.

Power to appoint special days to be public holidays. 3. The Governor in Council may, by public notice, appoint a special day to be kept as a public holiday either throughout Sierra Leone or in any part thereof, and any day so appointed shall be kept as a public holiday accordingly.

Power to cancel day appointed to be public holiday.

4. The Governor in Council may, in like manner, when it appears to him in any special case that in any year it is inexpedient that a day appointed by this Ordinance to be kept as a public holiday should be kept as a public holiday, declare that such day shall not be kept as a public holiday.
