# CHAPTER 98.

# FOREIGN MARRIAGE.

An Ordinance to give effect in the Colony to the Foreign  $^{10 \text{ of } 1914.}_{28 \text{ of } 1927.}$  Marriages Order in Council, 1913.

[15TH JUNE, 1914.]

Whereas by the Foreign Marriage Act, 1892, it is provided that all marriages between parties, of whom one at least is a British subject, solemnised in the manner in that Act provided in any foreign country or place by or before a marriage officer within the meaning of that Act shall be as valid in law as if the same had been solemnised in the United Kingdom with a due observance of all forms required by law:

AND WHEREAS His Majesty the King in Council is authorised by the said Act to make regulations, and by the Foreign Marriages Order in Council, 1913, regulations have been made under the said Act modifying (*inter alia*) the requirements of the said Act as to residence and notice.
